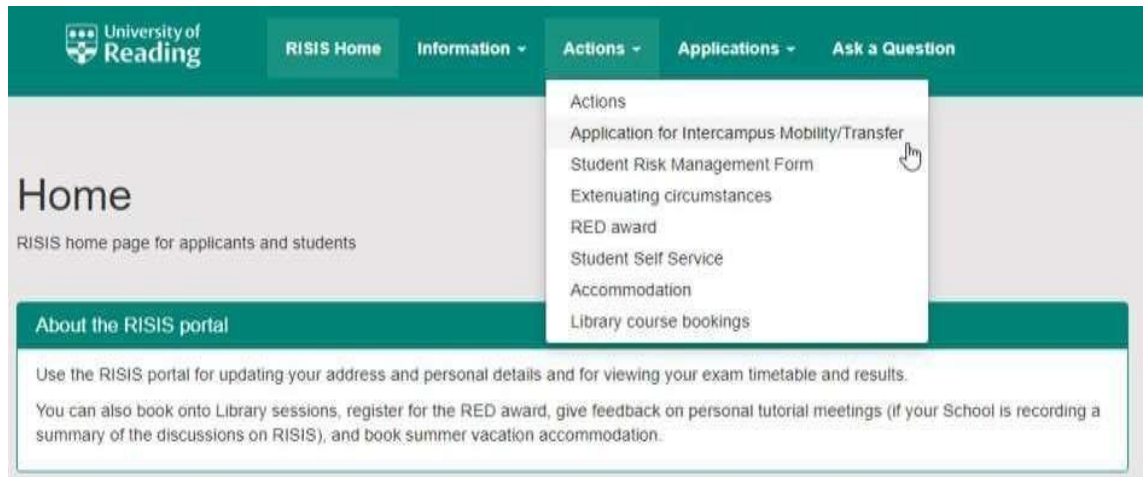

UoR-UoRM Expression of Interest Tool Guide – Study Abroad Office

Using the Expression of Interest Tool

1. Log into the RISIS Portal.
2. Go to the 'Actions' tab and select 'Application for Intercampus Mobility/Transfer'.



3. Select the 'Expression of interest for Intercampus Mobility/Transfer' link.



4. Select which mobility duration you wish to apply for, appropriate to your degree programme. You can find your options under [Available Mobility Periods](#) or on the [Study Abroad website](#).
 - a. Semester 1
 - b. Semester 2
 - c. Full year (semesters 1 and 2)
5. The Tool will ask for a second preference of mobility duration – please do not leave this blank.

6. Once you have selected your preferences, click save.

7. The deadline for your Expression of Interest is **Friday 8 March 2024 (14:00 UK Time)**.

8. After the application deadline, the Study Abroad Office (SAO) will liaise with relevant colleagues at UoR and UoRM to start the allocation process. Students will normally be notified of the decision in **mid-March** or informed in advance if there will be any delays.

a. **If you are successful:**

- You will be informed of your allocation by email.
- You will normally have 2-4 days to accept your conditional offer. Specific response timeframes will be stipulated in your allocation email.
- Once accepted, SAO and the UoRM International Office will provide you with information regarding next steps.

b. **If you are unsuccessful:**

- You will be notified by email and provided with an explanation.

Important Notes

1. We aim to inform all applicants of the decision by email, and at the same time.
2. If you fail to accept an offer within the timeframe stipulated in the decision email, you will lose the place, regardless of the reasons for non-response. It is your responsibility to ensure that you respond within the timeframe indicated.
3. Compulsory pre-departure sessions will be arranged. All students undertaking mobility are expected to attend in order to gain more information about processes and practicalities.

Applying to Other Destinations

The application process to study at UoRM is distinct from the application to study at other worldwide destinations. If you are applying to study abroad at:

- **UoRM only**

- **A worldwide partner and UoRM**
You need to submit an Application to Study Abroad in 2024/25 and an application via the UoRM Expression of Interest Tool on RISIS.
- **A worldwide partner only**
You only need to submit an Application to Study Abroad in 2024/25.
